6. Entrance is free, but donations would be welcome.
7. All exhibits must be in by 10.45 am (judging starts 11.00 am).

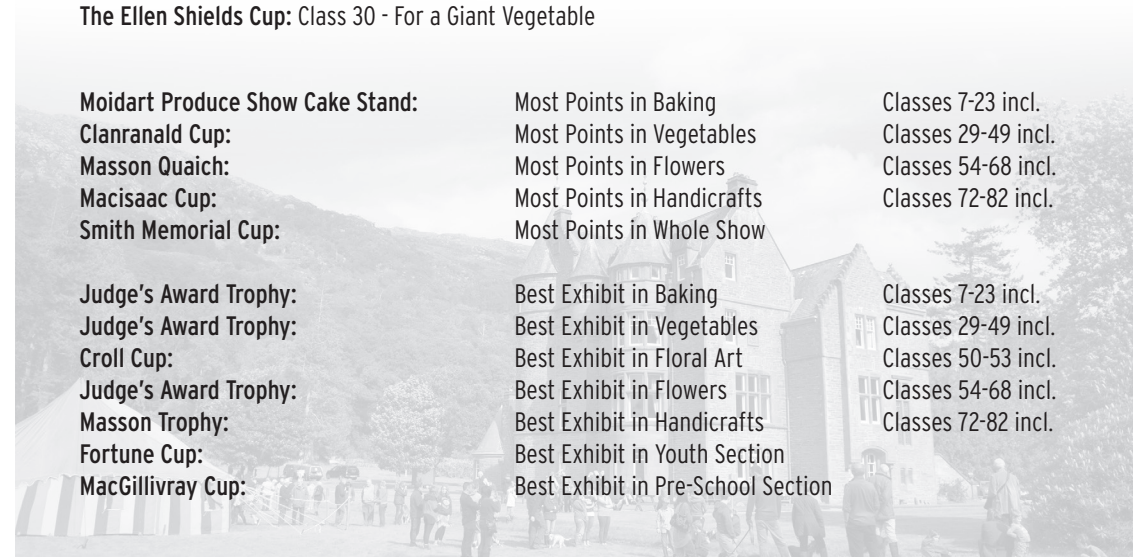
